THIS WILL NOT AFFECT THE FREQUENCY OF VISITS OR SERVICE WITH US. INSTEAD OF SENDING TWO SEPARATE CONTRACTS TO REFLECT THE INCREASES FOR 2024 AND 2025, I HAVE ENCLOSED A NEW CONTRACT FOR YOU TO REVIEW, SIGN AND RETURN WITH ENVELOPE PROVIDED.

- 7. Clean effluent filter, air or pump filters. (filter replacement extra cost)
- 8. Visually inspect the soil treatment area for problems with seepage, ponding, rodents, trees or plugging of laterals.
